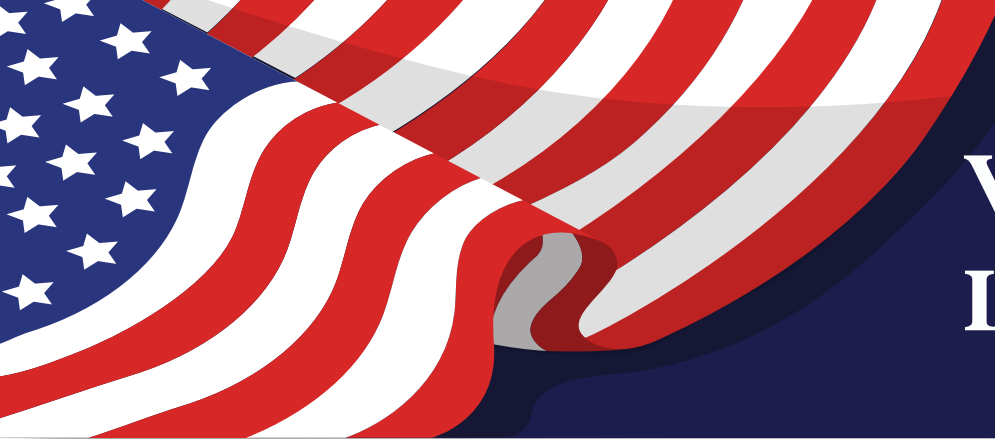

What is Carbon Monoxide?

Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odor-less, poisonous gas that can cause serious illness or death if inhaled in large concentrations for even a short period of time. Small amounts of CO are produced whenever fuel such as natural gas, oil, coal, or wood is burned. If your system is not working properly, these small amounts can build up over time to harmful levels.

CO Safety Tips

- Make sure your heating system is kept clean and properly vented, that any work or defective parts are replaced.
- Have your chimney and flue cleaned regularly to remove soot deposits, leaves, and other debris.
- Don't use your gas range to heat rooms, as this can reduce oxygen levels and cause CO buildup.
- Don't burn charcoal in your home or in an enclosed area.
- Automobile exhaust contains CO. Open your garage door before starting your car and don't leave the motor running in an enclosed area.
