CALL BEFORE YOU DIG!

Whether you are building an addition, laying a patio, planting a garden, or just digging a post hole for a mailbox, don't dig through the natural gas line! When you plan to do any digging, please CALL TENNESSEE ONE CALL, at least three days in advance so that all ORUD-owned pipes may be located and marked for you at no charge. All digging in the vicinity of piping should be carefully done by hand.

This will avoid the inconvenience

Starting this fall, customers with a past-due balance on their natural gas bill will no longer receive a door hanger.

ORUD will send a mailed final notice letter indicating the amount owed, a pay-by date, and the communication that their natural gas service is subject to be discontinued without further notice if the balance remains unpaid. This updated process will allow ORUD to better serve its customers by utilizing resources more effectively.

The date for the implementation of the final notice letter will be published and communicated to ORUD customers once it is established.
