**ANNUAL LEAK SURVEY REMINDER**

It is that time of year again! Time for ORUD Natural Gas' annual leak survey. As part of our commitment to safety, ORUD technicians will be working in neighborhoods during the next few months conducting its annual leakage control survey on the underground natural gas pipelines. This leak survey is done annually on 1/5 of the overall distribution system and at all schools, churches and business districts as required by the U.S. Department of Transportation. Although most leaks found are very minor, our job is to be proactive in searching out and repairing any leaks before they become a hazard!

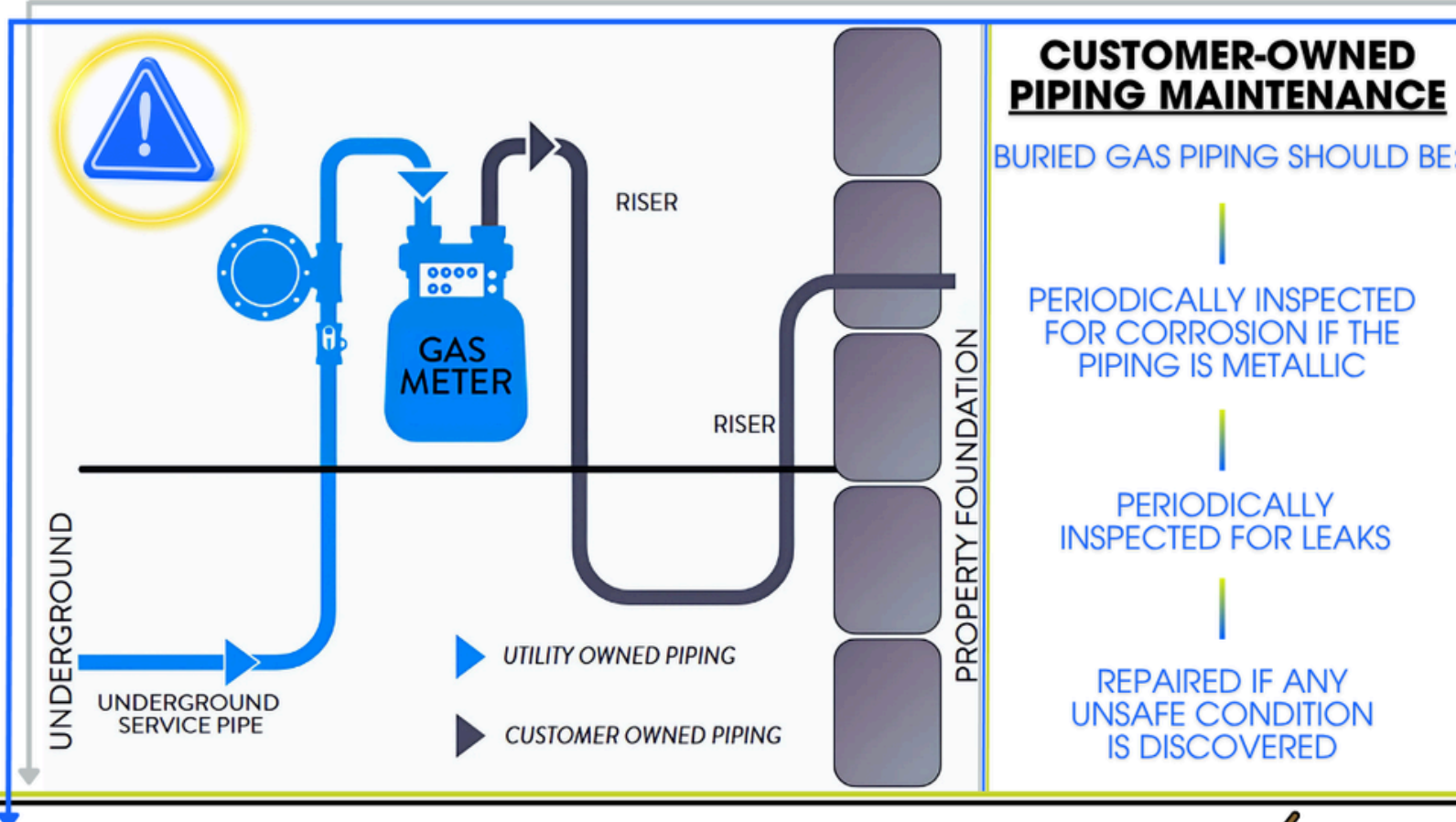

Property owners are responsible for maintaining and inspecting buried piping running from their gas meters to structures such as homes, businesses and other facilities, as well as aboveground piping extending from the meter to structures or equipment that utilize gas. Customer-owned piping that is not maintained properly may become subject to corrosion and leakage, which can result in fire, explosion, or temporary shut-off if a leak is detected.



Call 811 in advance to locate buried gas pipelines before excavating near them. Plumbing contractors and heating contractors can assist in locating, inspecting and repairing your buried piping.
